### ANOINTING OF THE SICK

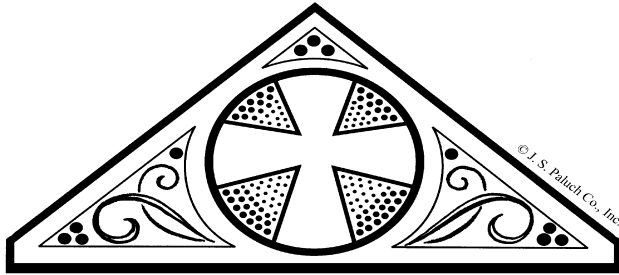

### ELLIE FUND

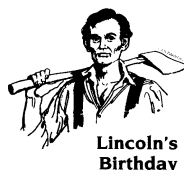

### SARAH'S LAW

This is a new Parental Notification Initiative, and signatures are now be gathered to qualify for the November '08 ballot. Petitions will be available for signing at tables on public sidewalks outside Church after all Masses next Saturday and Sunday. Sarah's Law amends the California Constitution to prohibit abortion for an unemancipated minor until 48 hours after the physician notifies minor's parent, legal guardian, or, if parental abuse reported, an adult family member. It provides exceptions for medical emergency or parental waiver; permits courts to waive notice based on clear and convincing evidence of a minor's maturity or best interest; and mandates reporting requirements from physicians. Full text of this initiative will be available at tables.
