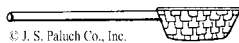

**LEGION OF MARY** meets every Wednesday, 8:45am, in the Jubilee Room. Everyone is welcome.

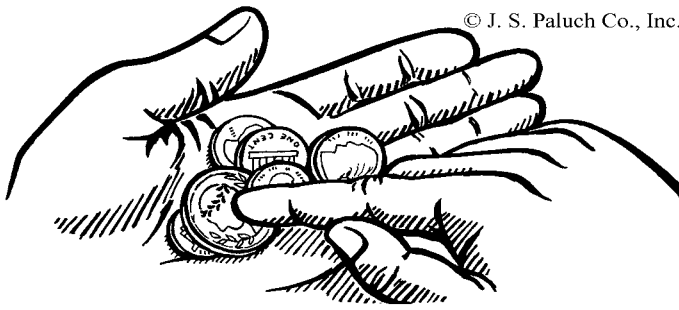
