TOGETHER IN MISSION 2006

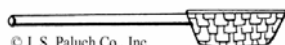
**"Blessed is the one who has

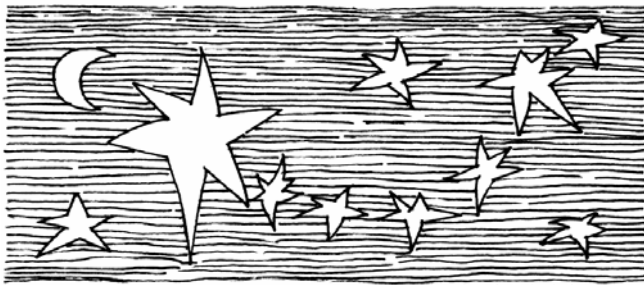
