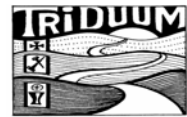

Good Friday—The Church takes up the yearly collection for the up-keep of the places in the Holy Land. Thank you for your generosity.

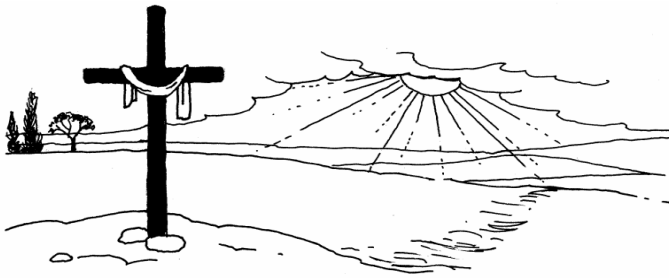
