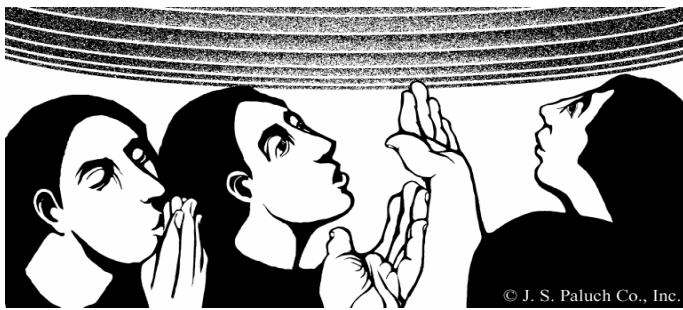


NEIGHBORHOOD BIBLE STUDY

PROPOSITION 73

Vote Yes on Prop. 73, November 8th.
