#### VOTE YES on 85—November 7th, Election Day

If passed, Prop. 85 will amend the California Constitution to: prohibit abortion for an unemancipated minor until 48 hrs. after her physician notifies her parent or legal guardian, except in medical emergency or with parent waive; permit a minor girl to obtain a court order waiving notice based on clear and convincing evidence of her maturity and best interests; and mandate various reporting requirements, including reports from physicians regarding abortion performed on minors. Currently girls as young as 12 can obtain abortions without parental knowledge; California public schools have authority to arrange for students (grades 7-12) confidential medical services (including abortion) without parents consent; and girls who can afford abortions can apply to tax-funded Medi-Cal to pay for the procedure.
