**CATHOLIC CAMPAIGN FOR
HUMAN DEVELOPMENT**

One in eight Americans lives in poverty, hunger and hardship. But one by one, working together, we can reverse the trend. Next week-end, November 19th/20th, is the date for the Catholic Campaign for Human Development Collections. This year we celebrate the 35th anniversary of this Campaign (CCHD). Since 1970, CCHD has worked in our name to help people break the cycle of poverty, not for just a day, but for a lifetime, through projects that support low income people as they work together to solve community problems, increase educational opportunities and create jobs.
